



AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA ORDER

Environment Act 1995 Part IV Section 83(1)

Central Bedfordshire Council

Air Quality Management Area Order No. 3

Central Bedfordshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following order.

This Order may be cited/referred to as the Central Bedfordshire Council Air Quality Management Area Order No. 3 and shall come into effect on 17th August 2015.

The area shown on the attached map in green is to be designated as an air quality management area (the designated area). The designated area incorporates

- part of Bedford Street, Ampthill, between Market Square to Brewers Lane (along both sides of the road incorporating numbers 1 to 19 and 2 to 22);
- part of Church Street, Ampthill between Market Square to St. Andrews Close (along both sides of the road incorporating numbers 1 to 43 and 2 to 40);
- part of Woburn Street, Ampthill along both sides of the road incorporating numbers 1 and 3;
- part of Dunstable Street, Ampthill along both sides of the road from Market Square incorporating numbers 114 to 86 and 123 to 99.

This area is designated in relation to a likely breach of the nitrogen dioxide (annual mean) objective as set out in the Air Quality (England) Regulations 2000 (SI928) and The Air Quality (England)(Amendment) Regulations 2002 (SI3043).

The Order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by a subsequent Order.

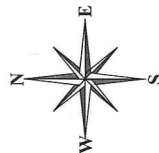
